[UN Headquarters, New York 24th November, 2006] CISRI-ISP Permanent Observer Mission to the United Nations/ECOSOC of the ***Intergovernmental Institution for the Use of Micro-algae Spirulina against Malnutrition*** in its endless pursuit to counter severe malnutrition across the globe through the use of micro-algae Spirulina would launch its mandate and affirmative action programmes in the Republic of Iraq, soon.

A recent visit of an official delegation under the leadership of CISRI-ISP's Ambassador and Special Envoy H.E. Cavaliere Philip Bonn, to the Republic of Iraq explored various avenues for CISRI-ISP to be a key stakeholder in the sustainable development and rebuilding of Iraq. The visit lasted from October 13th to the 16th 2006.

Besides the organization's key mandate to counter malnutrition by the use of micro-algae Spirulina, the delegation explored avenues like education and sports among

others, where CISRI-ISP could play a crucial role to make the world a peaceful and better place through sport and the Olympic ideal in its pursuit for the universal achievement of the United Nations Millennium Development Goals.



During the visit, the delegation prayed for the Iraqi people and the world peace, outside a former detention centre. The delegation also observed a one minute silence in the memory of the dead and the ones who were tortured.

Prior to its official meeting with the Ministry of Health in the Republic of Iraq, the delegation visited one of the most modern

hospitals in Sulaimani and interacted with patients along with a team of doctors from the hospital. The use of micro-algae Spirulina is being explored to counter many life threatening diseases that include HIV/AIDS and cancer among others besides its inherent potential to bridge the health divide in an effective and efficient manner within a very short span of time.



H.E. Cavaliere. Philip Bonn also addressed the young students of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Sulaimani and inspired them to take challenges with a stride. He emphasised the positive role that the medical community can play to bridge the global health divide and secure the Right to Food and quality nutrition.



Recognising the crucial role modern education can play along with its traditional counterpart in the empowerment and development process, H.E. Cavaliere Philip Bonn in the presence of Dr. Ali Saeed Mohammad, President of the University of Sulaimani announced CISRI-ISP's Scholarships for meritorious students to pursue their doctoral degree in the field of Human Rights.

(60/3)- Proclamation of the period '2001-2010' as "*The International Decade for a Culture of Peace and Non-Violence for the Children of the World*"

(1325) -Assuring women's participation in peace-making and peace-building

(56/168)- Ad Hoc Committee for a comprehensive and integral international convention to promote and protect the rights and dignity of persons with disabilities

Global Sports for Peace hopes to be a catalyst in organizing, securing, implementing, and assuring all stakeholders- Government, Private Sector, and Civil Society- contacts necessary to implement the programme. CISRI-ISP is accredited as an Observer with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), in keeping with resolution E/2003/212, dated 5th March 2003.

Its principal goal is to provide relief to emergency victims of calamities, through the use of food micro-algae Spirulina as an alternative low cost protein source to rehabilitate severely malnourished victims.
