He also discussed the possibility of establishing joint children care projects, especially with orphanages and the most vulnerable. **Ambassador Dr. Mohammed Bin Ibrahim Al-Tuwaijri, Assistant Secretary-General of the Arab League for Economic Affairs**, discussed mutual cooperation among the Arab institutions and the private sector. They also discussed the revival of the Arab States economies and bilateral investments, inter-Arab countries, towards contributing to the development of the Arabic economy and the achievement of the Arab peoples aspirations of prosperity. His Excellency also congratulated **Amb. Al Fahim** for promoting cultural sensitive sound commercial relations between different cultures as the Chairman of the Union of Arab Real Estate Development.
