IIMSAM's Goodwill Ambassador (GWA) Sheikh Dr. Tarik Al Abdullah has allocated four hectares of land for this project in Fallujah of a population of 450,000 inhabitants, 20% are children under the age of 12.

 - **Contacted the IIMSAM Turkish Partner Soley Institute support team for technology and Spirulina know how to transfer through Personal Training.**

 - **Recruitment of Medical and non Medical Staff for Fallujah Programme. Two doctors and two supervisors will travel to Turkey for training by November 2008. 20 Administrative and other general staff to be in place by February 2009.**

 - **IIMSAM`s GWA Sheikh Tarik Al Abdullah and his dedicated team in Fallujah will be Managing and Supervising the Spirulina Programme at the Field Level. Spirulina shall be brought from other IIMSAM supporting Spirulina producing**

countries to be given to schools and hospitals prior to letting the Fallujah Center established for the benefit of 112,000 children. November – December 2008.
