[New York, UN Headquarters, 9 July 2007] IIMSAM`s Head Ambassador Mr. Remigio Maradona commended the efforts of 25 year old actress **Ms. Lauren Evans**, IIMSAM`s Youth Delegate from the United Kingdom who will be cycling 160 miles of pain-staking stretch from Boston to Provincetown on the **27th and 28th July 2007** in order to raise funds for **IIMSAM`s Emergency Operations Fund**. Recognising the awareness and zeal of the modern youth to participate in processes to bring about a positive change in the world, Ambassador Maradona appreciated Lauren`s commitment towards IIMSAM and its mandate that she expressed as -

“I am starting my 2007 fundraising targets for IIMSAM (Intergovernmental Institution for the use of Micro-alga Spirulina against Malnutrition), by cycling from Boston to Provincetown. It will be a 160 mile ride and I will be cycling this challenge on 27th and 28th July, 2007. I hope to raise substantial funding for IIMSAM`s Emergency Operational Fund to promote and implement pilot-projects that will provide Spirulina to the malnourished in developing areas of the world. Spirulina builds up the immune and digestive systems of people in these countries that are suffering from severe malnutrition, so that they will later, be able to absorb food and recuperate. I will then go out to Africa later this fall, to aid IIMSAM`s initiatives there, so as to help feed these people in dire straits. The focus of this fundraising is to raise resources that will enable IIMSAM to save as many lives as possible, in these countries, so that they will be able to gain strength to eat and then eventually, through help, live via their own means.
